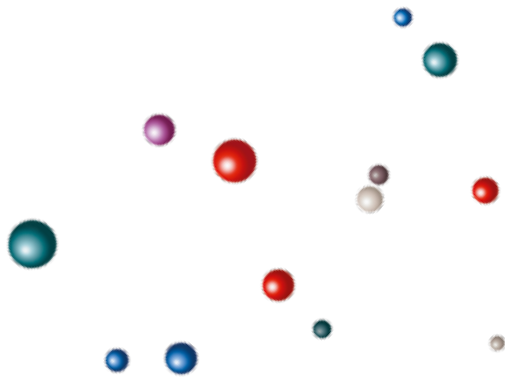
The modern workplace can be a challenging listening environment. It is also a place where successful communication is key in order to succeed.

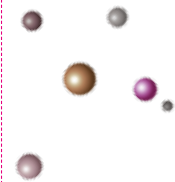

Roger microphones



Roger Table Mic

Roger Clip-On Mic

Wireless microphone; perfect in one-to-one conversations and for presenters.

Several microphones can be connected in a MultiTalker Network.

Roger X

Universal miniature receiver for behind-the-ear hearing aids, implants and streamers.



Roger MyLink

Small meetings



Meetings with a small group of people become overwhelming for people wearing hearing aids. Simply place a table microphone on the meeting table.

Large meetings



In a large meeting, you might need more than one Roger Table Mic. You can use as many table microphones as necessary.

Meetings with presenters

One-to-one conversation in noise



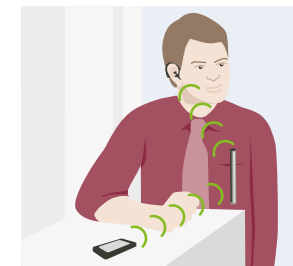
When surrounded by distracting noise, the most effective approach is to hang Roger Pen around your colleague's neck or clip on Roger Clip-On Mic on his collar.
