With the Roger Pen, hearing aid users understand up to 62% better than people without hearing loss in noise and over distance, which is impossible with any hearing aid alone¹. The device is easy to use, features wideband Bluetooth for wireless cell phone calls and transmits the sound from the TV wirelessly to the ears, making users' lives easier. A network can be made of up to 10 Roger Pens so that a hearing aid user can be wirelessly connected to multiple talkers, allowing them to converse in the most challenging of all environments: in high noise, over distance with multiple conversation partners.
