Phonak ComPilot and BlackBerry Bluetooth pairing guide

- 1. Charge and turn on the mobile phone and ComPilot.
- 2. Place them next to each other.

3. Prepare ComPilot for pairing

- Press and hold the Connect and Volume buttons simultaneously for 2 seconds until the Audio indicator starts to rapidly blink blue.
- Start the pairing process on the phone as described below.
- Please consult your phone's user guide if you need more information.



4. Prepare the mobile phone for pairing

Find the connectivity settings of the phone. With most models, the following navigation applies. The **Bold** terms might be different depending on the exact phone model.

Pairing older models

- Highlight and select All > Options >
 Networks and Connections >
 Bluetooth Connections
- Ensure Bluetooth is turned On
- Select Add New Device > Search
- Wait until Phonak ComPilot is found
- Select the ComPilot
- Press Select
- Enter the PIN code 0000 (4 zeros)
- Select Yes

Pairing smartphone models (touchscreen)

- Scroll to and touch Options > Networks
 and Connections > Bluetooth Connections
- Ensure Bluetooth is turned On
- Touch Add New Device > Search
- Wait until Phonak ComPilot is found
- Touch ComPilot
- Enter the passkey 0000 (4 zeros)
- Touch Enter > Yes

5. End of pairing

- After successful pairing, the ComPilot Audio indicator will stop rapid flashing blue.
- Additionally a headset symbol \bigcap may appear on the main screen of your phone.
- After 2 minutes the ComPilot will automatically exit from pairing mode. If step 4 was not completed before, simply start the pairing mode on ComPilot again as described in step 3.
