Bluetooth pairing information

Press and hold the call button (2 seconds) to switch EasyCall II on or off.



If EasyCall II has never been paired, it will automatically be in pairing mode for 60 minutes after turning on. This is indicated by a rapidly blinking blue indicator light.

To manually start pairing mode, press and hold the call button for 10 seconds until the indicator light starts to rapidly flash

On the phone, select "Phonak EasyCall II" from the list of Bluetooth devices and enter code "0000" if prompted.
