 Measure the maximum depth of insertion (mm) with the length sizer.





Device sizing process – determining best fit



- Did you meet your measured insertion depth? If no,
 - 1. Assess seal fit at achieved insertion depth and note the difference in the measured vs. achieved depth
 - 2. Remove device after inspecting the seals and insertion depth and proceed to smaller device sizer
- Did you have resistance upon inserting?
 - Too little resistance = poor acoustic seal, consider larger size.
 - Appropriate resistance = good acoustic seal and likely appropriate size.
 - Significant resistance = reasonable acoustic seal unless folding but consider smaller size.
- What is the patients' hearing loss?
 - More hearing loss, need to ensure good acoustic seal.





Introduction

Since 2008, Lyric has presented people with mild to moderate hearing loss a unique solution: 24/7 extended wear technology with deep ear canal placement that provides acoustic benefits along with complete device imperceptibility. Although the cosmetic and ease-of-use benefits of Lyric are relatively straightforward to assess, the acoustic advantages and resulting audibility improvement enabled by deep ear canal placement of the device can be more difficult for clinicians to capture. In this regard, real-ear measurement (REM) is a valuable verification technique that can objectively and accurately document the acoustic performance of a hearing instrument and offer details regarding the suitability of the device output relative to the patient's dynamic range.

In this paper, we will discuss and illustrate procedures that can be employed to increase the probability of successful and accurate REMs with Lyric.
